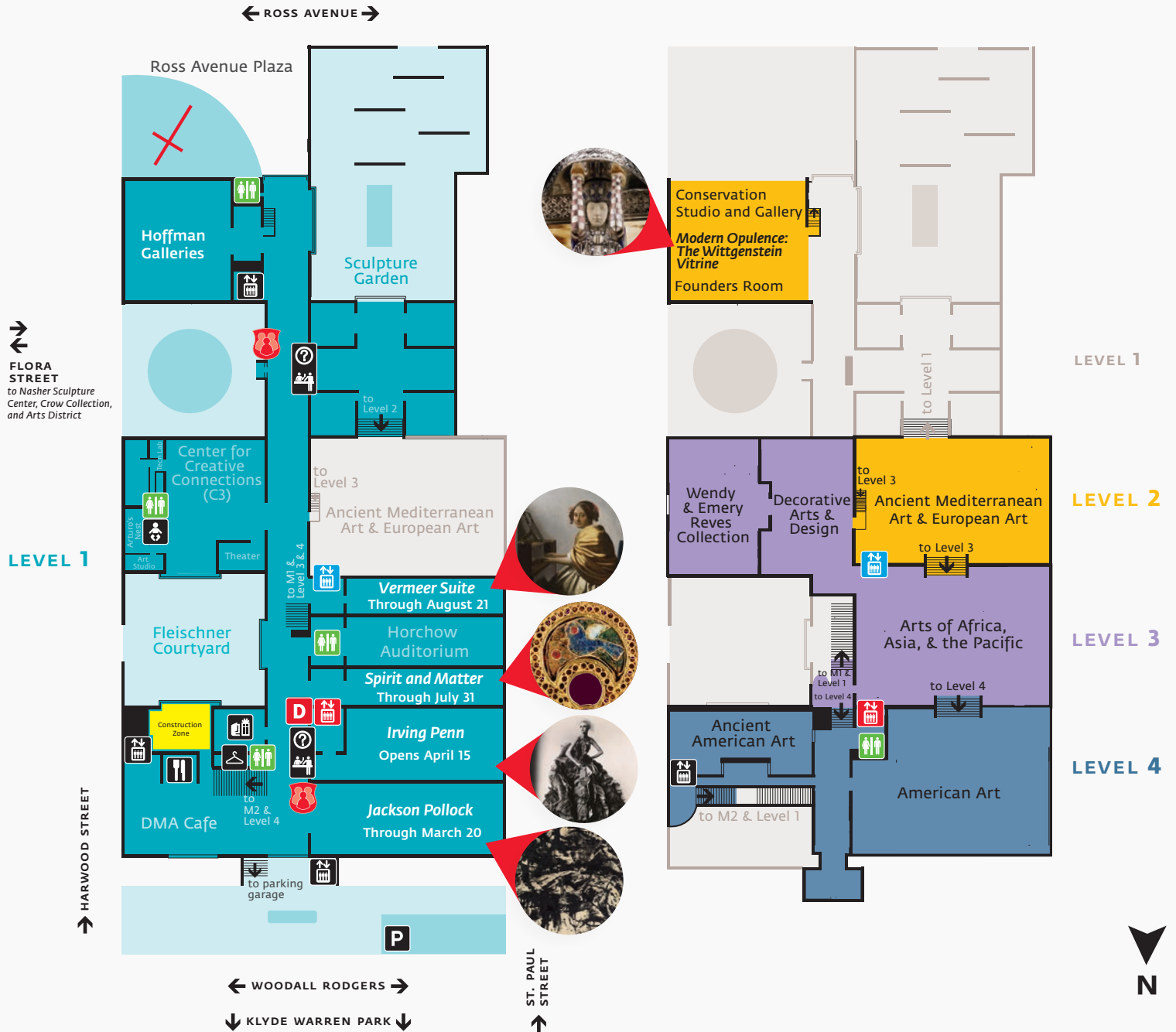


Mayer Library, Museum Offices, and Cook Boardroom are located on Mezzanine 1 and 2.
