

Snow Globe Sensations

Get into the seasonal spirit by turning any DMA artwork into a whimsical winter wonderland with this DIY snow globe activity.

Materials

- Printed image
- A glass jar or bottle
- Packaging tape
- Glitter and/or sequins
- Water
- Clear corn syrup

Steps

- Print out an image of an artwork from the [DMA's collection](#). Adjust the size to fit your glass bottle. It should be half an inch shorter than your bottle's height. Test the size of your image before moving on by slipping it inside the glass bottle. It should not curl around more than $\frac{3}{4}$ of your bottle. Some trimming may be necessary.
- Waterproof your image by laying it down on packaging tape. Cover both sides, making sure to seal it without any air bubbles. Trim the sides but leave at least a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch border of tape.
- Curl the photo and slip it into the glass jar upside down. Push the photo against an inside wall of the glass jar.
- Fill a little over half the jar with water. Fill the rest with clear corn syrup. Add glitter.
- Screw the lid on as tightly as possible. Flip the bottle upside down and shake it up. Set it down lid first and watch your wintry wonderland come to life.
- For bonus creativity points, decorate the lid.
